
9. PROCEDURE AND APPLICATION GUIDE

Depending on manufacture and model, some engine components do change. Please check with Autodata or the manufacturer's data before use.

Bolt the lever to the engine block as shown A, and lever the tensioner back. Use a suitable locking pin or locking plate, there are two different types of tensioner fitted as shown below. To lock the tensioner it must be in a retracted position.
