5. TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

5.1 IDENTIFICATION



- (1) 'IR' LED Used to indicate infrared signals. When the tester detects infrared signals, this LED flashes.
- (2) 'Ó' LED


 This LED is a power indicator.
 It lights up when the tester is
 turned on and turns off
 when the tester turns off
 automatically.
- (3) 'RF' LED Used to indicate radio frequency signals. When the tester detects radio frequency signals this LED flashes.
- (4) Reception window
 When you perform test, you should aim the key fob at the reception window.
- (5) '**b**' Key

 Press this key to turn on the tester. The tester will turn off automatically about 70 100 seconds later. **Note:** The tester can not be turned off manually.
- 6 9V PP3 Battery compartment Note: Battery not supplied.

6. OPERATION AND USE

6.1 INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Press the to turn on the tester. The LED lights up. The 'RF' LED lights for about 2 seconds and then turns off. Now you can start to perform the test.
- Move the vehicle key fob to be tested near the reception window of
 the tester and aim it perpendicular to the reception window, then
 operate the key fob. If the tester detects radio frequency or infrared
 emission from key fob, the corresponding LED will flash once.
 Note. for radio frequency detection, repeat the test several times to
 confirm the test result because radio frequency signals are easily
 interfered with. The required radio frequency range is: 418Mhz or
 433 434MHz.
- If the key fob does not trigger the corresponding LED, change the key fob's battery and repeat the procedure.
